## Colleges that Accept a Large Percentage of their Freshman Class through Early Decision

### Early Decision...what does it mean?

An admission program offered at certain colleges and universities with early deadlines (often November 1st or November 15th) and earlier notification dates (often January 1st or January 15th). Students who apply through an Early Decision program commits to attending that school if accepted. Students cannot apply to more than one school under the Early Decision program and not every single college offers Early Decision.

The number listed after the school's name is the percentage of the freshman class admitted through Early Decision.
